

This conference, including 12 keynote speeches, focused on



n Nov. 13, an opening ceremony of Tsinghua-Veolia Environment and Urban Management Advanced Program (hereinafter referred to as EUMAP) was held at DESE. Mr. Luc Zeller, Chief Finance Officer of Veolia Environnement Asia, and Mr. Yu Gang, Dean of the Department of Environmental Science & Engineering of Tsinghua University (hereinafter referred to as DESE) attended and addressed the ceremony on behalf of the sponsors. Also in attendance were local government officials from across the country, program participants from NGOs and media. This year's program is focused on waste incineration and power generation, investment and financing management in the environment sector and many other hot topics.

The program lasts five years, with around 20 participants from across the nation each year, attending lectures given by senior officials from Chinese government, experts from Tsinghua University and other academic institutions, renowned European environmentalists and municipal



experts, all invited by sponsors. A study tour in France and other European countries is also included to introduce developed countries' efforts and experiences



to achieve sustainable development through environmental protection and urban management. To complement lectures and study tours, participants can also attend workshops and symposiums to discuss how to apply what they learn into practice. This year's program runs eight days and is divided into two parts. The first part includes lectures by professors from DESE and officials from Ministry of Environmental Protection and National Development and Reform Commission and a visit to the water quality control demonstration project at the Olympic Green. Then the second part will take place in Paris, France, where European environmentalists and government officials will discuss with participants about the environmental and urban management systems in France and Europe, plus visits to municipal infrastructures such as water and waste treatment facilities and three dimensional transportation networks. This year's program aims at boosting decision-making capabilities with theoretical instructions and combined experiences in China and Europe and thus pushing forward the agenda for energy conservation and sustainable development.
